GAME 8 STORYLINES

1. SECOND MEETING: EMU and Northwestern will be meeting for the second time. Northwestern won the first game, 14-6, Sept. 16, 2006, in Evanston.

2. FIRST BIG TEN TEAM HOSTED BY EMU: The EMU-Northwestern football game Friday night (Oct. 19) is a home game for the Eagles and marks the first time that EMU has played host to a Big Ten opponent.

3. COLLEGIATE CLASH IV: The EMU-Northwestern game Friday, Oct. 19, will be the fourth annual Collegiate Clash at Ford Field in Detroit. The inaugural Collegiate Clash was held, Nov. 6, 2004, when the Eagles recorded a 61-58 four-overtime victory over Mid-American West Division rival Central Michigan. That first year's game was also part of a doubleheader with Wayne State and Hillsdale squaring off in the opener. Collegiate Clash II went to a single-game format with EMU dropping a 44-36 decision to MAC West Division rival Western Michigan, Nov. 5, 2005. Last year, Nov. 11, 2006, the Eagles hosted non-conference rival Navy and the Midshipmen recorded a 49-21 victory.

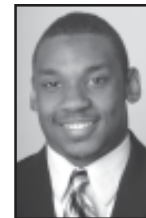

SATURDAY PREVIEW: The EMU football team will go out of Mid-American Conference for the last time this season when the Eagles host the Big Ten's Northwestern University Friday (Oct. 19) in the fourth annual Collegiate Clash at Ford Field in Detroit. Northwestern is coming off back-to-back overtime wins, with a 48-41 victory at Michigan State (Oct. 6) and a 49-48 double-overtime thriller at home last weekend (Oct. 13) against Minnesota. The Wildcats are 4-3 overall and 2-2 in the Big Ten. The Eagles are also coming off a big offensive showing with a 48-42 setback at Ohio last weekend. Eastern is 2-5 overall and 1-2 in the MAC. The game will mark the first time in history that EMU has hosted a Big Ten opponent. Game time is set for 7 p.m. The game will be televised on ESPNU with Gary Williams handling the play-by-play duties while Jay Taylor will serve as the analyst.

MID-SEASON ACCOLADES: Five EMU players have earned mention on *Phil Steele's College Football Preview* magazine mid-season All-American and All-Mid-American Conference rankings. Senior defensive tackle **Jason Jones (Southfield, Mich.-Lathrup)** was chosen fourth-team All-American on the mid-season list. In addition, Jones, **Khalid Walton (Southfield, Mich.-Southfield)** and **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Okla.-Enid)** were all named mid-season first-team All-MAC while **Andy Fretz (Kalamazoo, Mich.-Central)** and **Darran Matthews (Redford, Mich.-Thurston)** were selected to the All-MAC second team.

NATIONALLY RANKED: EMU has several players and several areas on the team ranked near the top of the latest national and Mid-American Conference statistical reports. Senior defensive tackle **Jason Jones (Southfield, Mich.-Lathrup)** is tied for fifth in the nation and is first in the Mid-American Conference in tackles-for-loss at 2.00 per game. Junior linebacker **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Okla.-Enid)** is tied for sixth in the NCAA in tackles and first in the MAC with 11.6 tackles per game and redshirt freshman safety **Ryan Downard (Lima, Ohio-Shawnee)** is tied for 15th in the NCAA and tied for third in the MAC in interceptions at .57 per game. EMU is second in the MAC in punting (39.9) and third in sacks against at 55.

EAGLES DIAL LONG DISTANCE AGAIN: The 2007 Eagles have taken advantage of several long-distance efforts for big plays this season. In the Ohio game last weekend (Oct. 13) sophomore defensive back **Derrick Hunter (Southfield, Mich.-Southfield)** was the latest player to turn in a long-distance touchdown when he raced 80 yards with a fumble return for a score against the Bobcats. That fumble-return was the first for an EMU player since defensive back **Jerry Gaines** returned one 82 yards against Buffalo (Sept. 2, 2004). Redshirt sophomore kick returner **Dontayo Gage (Pontiac, Mich.-Northern)** has recorded two long kickoff returns already this year, with a 90 yarder for a score against Ball State (Sept. 8) and an 86-yard return at Michigan (Oct. 6) which eventually led to an EMU touchdown. Redshirt freshman safety **Ryan Downard (Lima, Ohio-Shawnee)** raced 97 yards with a blocked PAT kick for a two-point defensive conversion score at Michigan and sophomore wide receiver **DeAnthony White (Kennesaw, Ga.-Kell)** recorded a 68-yard run for a touchdown at Northern Illinois (Sept. 14).

TWO FOR TWO: Wide receiver **Jacory Stone (Cleveland, Ohio-Glenville)** and quarterback turned wide receiver **Tyler Jones (Belleville, Mich.-Belleville)** both turned in two-touchdown reception outings last weekend at Ohio (Oct. 13). Stone hauled in touchdown grabs of 17 and eight yards while Jones recorded scoring grabs of seven and five yards against the Bobcats.

TWO FOR FOUR: EMU redshirt sophomore quarterback **Andy Schmitt (St. John's, Mich.-St. John's)** recorded the second four-passing touchdown game in his short career when he had four against Ohio last weekend (Oct. 13). Schmitt had his first four-touchdown day against Howard (Sept. 22) Those four-touchdown pass performances tied for second-best in school history, a feat that has been accomplished 13 times. **Kainoa Akina** holds the EMU single-game record with six touchdown tosses, Nov. 24, 2001, at Akron.

ROOKIE GETS SECOND: True freshman quarterback **Kyle McMahon (Rochester Hills, Mich.-Pontiac Notre Dame Prep)** has made the most of two relief performances in place of starter **Andy Schmitt (St. Johns, Mich.-St. Johns)**. He recorded the second touchdown pass of his career when he found **Tyler Jones (Belleville, Mich.-Belleville)** for a five-yard score at Ohio last weekend (Oct. 13). He made the most of his relief role at Michigan (Oct. 6), throwing an 18-yard scoring toss to redshirt freshman **Tyrone Burke (Syracuse, NY-Corcoran)** with just 00:47 left in the game. McMahon then rushed for the two-point conversion.

THIRD FOR TWO: EMU turned in its third defensive PAT score in school history when **Ryan Downard (Lima, Ohio-Shawnee)** scooped up a blocked Michigan PAT by teammate **Jason Jones (Southfield, Mich.-Lathrup)** and raced 97 yards with the ball for two points against the Wolverines last weekend (Oct. 6). That effort was the first defensive two points ever recorded in against Michigan. The Eagles' second-ever PAT defensive score came against Toledo last season (Oct. 21, 2006) when **Darran Matthews (Redford, Mich.-Thurston)** ran 87 yards with a Rocket fumble on a two-point conversion try. The first-ever defensive PAT score was turned in by EMU linebacker **Scott Russell** who returned a blocked PAT attempt 86 yards for two points at home against Northern Illinois (Nov. 11, 2000). The Eagles have had only one PAT ever returned for two points against them. Central Michigan's Ronnie Jackson ran a blocked PAT kick attempt back for two points, Nov. 6, 2004, at Ford Field in Detroit.

MASTER THIEF: Redshirt freshman safety **Ryan Downard (Lima, Ohio-Shawnee)** has made the most of his chance to start, recording four interceptions in four games as a starter. Downard was called on to fill in for the injured **Chris May (Jupiter, Fla.-Dwyer)** after the Ball State game (Sept. 8) and he turned in his first interception in his second game as a starter, against Howard University (Sept. 22). He then came up with two picks at Vanderbilt (Sept. 29) and recorded an interception in the end zone to stop a potential Michigan touchdown in Ann Arbor (Oct. 6). Downard is currently tied for 15th in the NCAA rankings at .57 per game.

116th SEASON OPENER: The EMU at Pitt football game (Sept. 1) was the 116th season-opening game for the Eagles and they now hold a 52-56-8 record in lid-lifters.

HUGE RALLY: After staking Ohio to a 28-0 lead after the first 18 minutes of the game last weekend (Oct. 13) the Eagles roared back by out-scoring the Bobcats, 42-28, the rest of the way. Eastern pulled within six, 48-42, with just 01:07 left in the game but a failed on-side kick halted any further EMU comeback hopes.

CAPTAINS NAMED: EMU will have five captains for the 2007 season. The captains, as voted by the players, are: **Ken Bohnet (Grand Ledge, Mich.-Grand Ledge), Jason Jones (Southfield, Mich.-Lathrup), Darran Matthews (Redford, Mich.-Thurston), Andy Schmitt (St. John's, Mich.-St. John's), and Pierre Walker (Detroit, Mich.-Central).**

SMALL SENIOR CLASS: The senior class is the smallest group on the 2007 Eagles' roster. A total of 11 seniors will be suiting up for the last time for the Green and White this fall. The seniors are listed below.

HOLTZCLAW EARNS WEEKLY MAC AWARD: Junior linebacker **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Okla.-Enid)** was named Mid-American Conference West Division Defensive Player of the Week for the Northern Illinois game (Sept. 15). The 6-foot-1 Holtzclaw had 13 tackles, one tackle-for-loss of three yards, one pass breakup and an interception in NIU territory that led to the game-winning EMU touchdown.

DOWNARD NAMED MAC-WEST DEFENSIVE POW: Redshirt freshman safety **Ryan Downard (Lima, Ohio-Shawnee)** was named Mid-American Conference West Division Defensive Player of the Week for his outstanding effort in EMU's game at Michigan (Oct. 6). Downard turned in a complete all-around game as one of the starting safeties in a close 33-22 non-conference loss to the Wolverines. He intercepted a pass in the end zone to stop a potential Michigan touchdown. He also ran back a blocked PAT kick for 97 yards and two points, the first-ever defensive score in history against the Wolverines, and the third defensive score in EMU history.

LONG DISTANCE BEST: EMU redshirt sophomore **Dontayo Gage (Pontiac, Mich.-Northern)** set a Rynearson Stadium record for an EMU player with a 90-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in EMU's 38-16 loss to Ball State Saturday (Sept. 8). That return was the third-best in stadium history. The record is 94 yards by Miami's Tremayne Banks (Oct. 12, 1996) while Western Michigan's Ron Rogers returned a kickoff 92 yards in a game played (Sept. 29, 2001). Gage's return broke the EMU Rynearson record of 88 yards by Craig Thompson (Sept. 9, 1993) versus Temple. That return was also just the fourth kickoff return for a touchdown in stadium history. It was also the first EMU return of any kind for a touchdown since Jerry Gaines returned a fumble 82 yards (Sept. 2, 2004) against Buffalo.

WHITE JUST MISSES THE CENTURY MARK: Sophomore **DeAnthony White (Kennesaw, Ga.-Kell)** just missed the magic mark of 100 yards in receptions when he hauled in seven passes for 94 yards in the home opener against Ball State (Sept. 8).

STARTING A HABIT: Two EMU players have earned starts in every game during their Eagle careers. Long snapper **Jerry Topolinski (Grand Blanc, Mich.-Flint Powers)** has been a fixture in the long-snapping department for the Eagles, starting all 41 games the past four seasons. Middle linebacker **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Okla.-Enid)** has started all 30 games during his three-year career. Offensive lineman **T.J. Lang (Ferndale, Mich.-Birmingham Brother Rice)** was a starter in all 12 games last season and has started all seven games this season.

STATELY BREAKDOWN: The 2007 EMU football roster has 60 players from the state of Michigan, 15 from Ohio, eight from Florida, two each from Indiana and Virginia, and one apiece from Washington D.C., Wisconsin, Oklahoma, Illinois, New York and Georgia.

TWO-SPORT MAN: EMU senior wide receiver **Travis Lewis (Kalamazoo, Mich.-Loy Norrix)** is one of a handful of college football players that have double duties in both football and basketball. He has earned three letters in football and two in basketball. In football he has played in 41 games, starting 23 times with 65 career receptions for 661 yards with four touchdowns scored. Lewis joined the basketball team at the end of the 2005 and 2006 football seasons and has played in 43 games, starting 20 times, and has scored 101 points (2.4 ppg) and hauled down 167 (3.9 rpg) rebounds in those two years. He is known as one of the top defenders on the hoops squad and was named the winner of the Earl Boykins Award as the 2007 men's basketball team's top defensive player.

PLAYERS GET A VOICE: EMU head football coach **Jeff Genyk** has credited a newly formed Leadership Council with helping the team work harder in the off season. The 16-player council was established at the end of the 2006 season and they meet with the coaching staff weekly with the Leadership Council to discuss their concerns and help to keep them on track. COACH HAS A VOTE: Eastern Michigan head football coach **Jeff Genyk** will be involved in weekly coaches' polls for 2007. Genyk, the fourth-year head coach of the Eagles' football squad, will be one of 60 head coaches that will vote in the weekly *USA Today* Coaches' Poll that will pick the top 25 teams in the NCAA Bowl Championship Series each week of the season.

COLLEGIATE CLASH: For the fourth year in a row the EMU football team will be taking one of its home games on the road, hosting a Big Ten team for the first time ever in the fourth annual Collegiate Clash at Ford Field, home of the Detroit Lions, in Detroit. EMU will be the host team for the non-conference battle with game time set for 7 p.m. Friday, Oct. 19. The Eagles hosted Central Michigan in the inaugural Collegiate Clash (Nov. 6, 2004), and Eastern won a thriller, 61-58, in four overtimes. In 2005 EMU hosted Western Michigan (Nov. 5, 2005), and lost a 44-36 shootout. Last year Navy recorded a 49-21 win (Nov. 5, 2006), in the game at Ford Field.

ZACH JOHNSON NAMED TO PRESEASON RAY GUY LIST:

EMU redshirt sophomore punter **Zach Johnson (Springboro, Ohio-Springboro)** has been named to the 2007 Ray Guy Award Preseason Watch List. He was one of 10 semifinalists for the 2006 award, won by Daniel Sepulveda of Baylor. Joining Johnson on this year's preseason watch list are Durant Brooks (Georgia Tech-Sr.), Geoff Price (Notre Dame-Sr.), Louie Sakoda (Utah-Jr.) and Sam Swank (Wake Forest-Jr.). The Ray Guy Award is presented to the nation's best collegiate punter as determined by a national selection committee comprised of sports writers, college football coaches, sports information directors, former punters and members designated by the Greater Augusta Sports Council. Among the statistics used to identify the Ray Guy Award winner are total yardage punted, number of times a punt is downed or kicked out of bounds inside the opponent's 20-yard line, net average, average returned yardage, and percentage of punts not returned. It is also of importance for the award winner to display team leadership, self-discipline and to have a positive impact on the team's success. The Ray Guy Award Watch List will be expanded after the start of the season when statistical figures can be added. The national voting body will then vote for the top three finalists who will be announced at the end of November. In December the top three finalists will be in Orlando, Fla. for the Home Depot College Football awards show. The winner will be announced live on ESPN. Johnson, who spent the entire 2006 season as the holder on field goal and PAT kick attempts, was the starting punter in the last 11 games of the season. Then-senior **Andrew Wellock (Canton, Ohio-Green)** was the returning field-goal kicker and punter when the 2006 season opened, and he started the first game of the 2006 season at both positions. Johnson was then called upon to take over the punting chores in game two and quickly established himself as one of the top punters in the NCAA Division I ranks. He finished the season with a 40.0 yard average, punting 65 times for 2,603 yards, including dropping 20 punts inside the 20-yard line. He was named an honorable mention Freshman All-American by *The Sporting News*.

HOLTZCLAW SELECTED TO ROTARY LOMBARDI LIST: EMU junior middle linebacker Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, OK-Enid) has been named to the Rotary Lombardi watch list for the 2007 season. He is one of 108 players named to the list, which honors the top lineman in college football. Holtzclaw finished the 2006 season as the leading tackler in the Mid-American Conference with 114 tackles, also good for 16th in the nation. He started this season with a team-leading 10 tackles at Pitt (Sept. 8). The 6-foot-1 Holtzclaw has been a starter in 29 consecutive games over the past three seasons and has accumulated 273 career tackles. EAGLES DROP 27-3 OPENER AT PITT

PITTSBURGH, Pa.—The Eastern Michigan University football team scored first but Pittsburgh came back with 27 unanswered points in a 27-3 setback for the Eagles here Saturday night in a non-conference game at Pitt's Heinz Field.

The game was the season opener for both teams and gives Pitt a 2-0 lead in the series.

Sophomore quarterback **Andy Schmitt (St. John's Mich.-St. John's)** completed 16-of-27 passes for 106 yards. Senior **Pierre Walker (Detroit, Mich.-Central)** led the Eagles' rushing attack with 11 carries for 30 yards. Defensively, junior **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Okla.-Enid)** led Eastern with 10 tackles, while sophomore **Chris May (Jupiter, Fla.-Dwyer)** added nine tackles.

The Panthers were led by junior quarterback Bill Stull who was 14-of-20 for 177 yards and a touchdown before leaving in the third quarter with an injury to his throwing hand. Freshman running back LeSean McCoy rushed for 68 yards while sophomore Shane Brooks rushed for 12 yards and a pair of touchdowns.

Eastern Michigan got on the board first with 3:30 left in the first quarter as redshirt freshman **Sean Dutcher (Owosso, Mich.-Owosso)** split the uprights for a 27-yard field goal to give the Eagles an early 3-0 advantage. However, Pittsburgh quickly drove 65 yards in five minutes before Shane Brooks scampered into the end zone for a touchdown with 1:26 left in the quarter to give the Panthers the 7-3 edge.

Following an EMU turnover the Panthers expanded the margin to 11 points, 14-3, as Bill Stull connected with Oderick Turner for a 21-yard touchdown strike with 14:05 remaining in the second quarter.

The Green and White strung together a 14-play, 49-yard drive midway through the second period, but the drive stalled at the 23-yard line. Dutcher once again was called upon to put points on the board but his 40-yard field goal attempt was just short.

That was all the scoring the rest of the period as the defense for both sides stepped up to limit the opposing offense. For the period the Eagles racked up 96 total yards compared to 154 for Pitt.

Following the intermission, the Panthers marched 60 yards in 11 plays before Brooks capped off the drive with a one-yard touchdown dive with 5:49 left in the third quarter. Pittsburgh would tack on a pair of late field goals to reach the game's final margin of 24, 27-3.

The Eagles return to Ypsilanti, Mich. next Saturday, Sept. 8, to open the Mid-American Conference portion of the schedule against West Division foe Ball State University. Game time is set for noon at EMU's Rynearson Stadium. The game is billed as Eagle Nation Day; at halftime of the contest, EMU will celebrate the 20th anniversary of the 1987 California Bowl and Mid-American Conference championships.

EAGLES FALL IN MAC OPENER

YPSILANTI, Mich. — The return of the players and coaching staff from the 1987 Mid-American Conference and California Bowl champions wasn't enough for the Eastern Michigan University football team as it fell to a visiting Ball State team, 38-16, here Saturday afternoon in Rynearson Stadium.

The day marked the 20th anniversary of the 1987 team and more than 75 players and coaches were on hand for the season opener.

It was a disappointing ending for both the guests and the current EMU squad as the Eagles were limited to just 262 yards in total offense to 459 for the Cardinals.

Despite the loss the Eagles had two bright plays during the game. The first one game as redshirt sophomore quarterback **Andy Schmitt (St. John's, Mich.-St. John's)** connected with sophomore wide receiver **DeAnthony White (Kennesaw, GA-Kell)** on a 67-yard touchdown pass in the second quarter. The second huge play came in the fourth quarter as sophomore wide receiver and kick return specialist **Dontayo Gage (Pontiac, Mich.-Northern)** set a Rynearson Stadium record with a 90-yard kickoff return for a touchdown. That return broke the stadium record of 88 yards by Craig Thompson against Temple (Sept. 9, 1993).

The Eagles' offense was paced by senior tailback **Pierre Walker (Detroit, Mich.-Central)** who rushed for 65 yards on 15 carries. Schmitt completed 16-of-24 passes for 155 yards and one touchdown.

Defensively the Eagles were led by the linebacking trio of **Andre Hatchett (Indianapolis, Ind.-Warren Central)**, **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, OK-Enid)** and **Darran Matthews (Redford, Mich.-Thurston)** with nine tackles each. EMU also recorded eight tackles-for-loss of 26 yards, with **Jason Jones (Southfield, Mich.-Lathrup)** notching three for 10 yards.

Eastern, now 0-2 overall and 0-1 in MAC action, will travel to DeKalb, Ill. next Saturday, Sept. 15, for a MAC West Division battle with Northern Illinois. Game time is 11 a.m. (CDT).

With the win Ball State moves to 1-1 overall and 1-1 in the MAC.

EAGLES USE BLOCKED FIELD GOAL TO WIN THRILLER

DeKALB, Ill. — A blocked field goal by senior defensive end **Eric Young (Shiocton, Wisc.-Shiocton-North Iowa C.C.)** on the game's final play preserved a thrilling 21-19 Eastern Michigan University Mid-American Conference West Division victory over Northern Illinois here at Brigham Field at Huskie Stadium Saturday.

The visiting Eagles held the tenuous two-point lead when Northern Illinois took possession of the ball on the NIU 39-yard line with 1:54 left in the game.

The Huskies advanced the ball to the EMU 33-yard line and called time out with 11 seconds left and called on senior place-kicker Chris Nendick to attempt a 50-yard field goal.

That left it all up to the EMU defense and they rose to the occasion, getting a tremendous surge from the front four with Young breaking through for the timely block.

The last-second heroics were set up by a stingy EMU defense and a resurgent offense after the Eagles trailed 13-0 heading into the second quarter.

After that sluggish first quarter, the Green and White rallied to out score the Huskies 21-6 over the final three quarters.

Head coach **Jeff Genyk's** Eagles used a balanced offensive attack to pull off the win, recording 189 yards on the ground and 189 yards through the air.

Sophomore **DeAnthony White (Kennesaw, Ga.-Kell)** was the big-play man on offense, scoring on a 68-yard run and also had a 38-yard pass reception that led to a touchdown one play later. Senior tailback **Pierre Walker (Detroit, Mich.-Central)** was a workhorse on offense, rushing 25 times for 66 yards and two touchdown runs of one yard each.

Linebackers **Andre Hatchett (Indianapolis, Ind.-Warren Central)** and **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Ok.-Enid)** each recorded 13 tackles for the EMU defense.

After Northern Illinois raced out to the 13-0 lead, the Eagles got on the board with just 22 seconds left in the second quarter when Walker bulldozed through the NIU defense for a one-yard score with **Sean Dutcher (Owosso, Mich.-Owosso)** adding the PAT.

Eastern came out of halftime on a mission, taking its first lead of the game, 14-13, on the spectacular 68-yard touchdown run by White, aided by a downfield block by quarterback **Andy Schmitt (St. John's. Mich.-St. John's)**. Dutcher added the PAT.

The Eagles increased that advantage to 21-13 on another one-yard Walker touchdown run after Holtzclaw intercepted a pass at the NIU 16-yard line. That was the sixth pick of Holtzclaw's career. Dutcher again added the PAT.

Northern pulled within two, 21-19, with 04:20 left on a seven-yard touchdown pass, missing a two-point conversion pass to set up the final late-game drama.

Eastern, now 1-2 overall and 1-1 in the MAC, will head out of MAC play this Saturday, Sept. 22, when it hosts Howard University in a 3:30 p.m. game in Rynearson Stadium.

EAGLES MAKE IT TWO IN A ROW WITH 38-15 WIN OVER HOWARD

YPSILANTI, Mich. — The Eastern Michigan University football team made it two consecutive wins with a convincing 38-15 non-conference win over a visiting Howard University squad here Saturday, Sept. 22, in Rynearson Stadium.

EMU redshirt sophomore quarterback **Andy Schmitt (St. John's, Mich.-St. John's)** directed an Eagles' offense that took advantage of five Howard turnovers to score a season-high 38 points. Schmitt completed 14-of-21 passes for 214 yards and four touchdowns, tying the EMU record for second-most touchdown passes in a single game.

Schmitt called on four different receivers for touchdowns in the game. Schmitt hooked up with freshman tailback **Dwayne Priest (Roanoke, Va.-William Fleming-Fork Union Academy)** on a 24-yard touchdown strike followed by a four-yard touchdown pass to senior **Ken Bohnet (Grand Ledge, Mich.-Grand Ledge)**, a 35-yard TD strike to redshirt freshman **Tyrone Burke (Syracuse, NY-Corcoran)** and a 10-yard scoring strike to senior **Travis Lewis (Kalamazoo, Mich.-Loy Norrix)**.

Redshirt sophomore punter **Zach Johnson (Springboro, Ohio-Springboro)** turned in an outstanding special teams effort, punting six times for a 41.8 yards, booting a field goal of 22 yards and kicking all five PAT's.

Defensively, the Eagles were paced by junior linebacker **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Ok-Enid)** who had a career-best 19 tackles, the 12th double-digit effort in his three seasons on the team.

The Eagles pounced on the Bison early, recovering the game's opening kickoff on the Howard 19-yard line. Senior **Pierre Walker (Detroit, Mich.-Central)** then rushed twice, for 12 yards on the first run followed by a seven-yard touchdown burst on the second play from scrimmage. Johnson added the PAT for a 7-0 lead.

Johnson then booted a 22-yard field goal to stake the Eagles to a 10-0 lead. Priest caught his 24-yard touchdown pass from Schmitt with Johnson adding the PAT to help EMU close out the first half with a 17-0 advantage.

The Eagles then scored twice in the third quarter, on Bohnet's four-yard reception and Burke's 35-yard score. Johnson booted both PAT's for a 31-0 EMU lead with 3:59 left in the third quarter.

Howard finally got on the board with two quick scores, the first an 11-yard pass to make it 31-7 with 40 seconds left in the third quarter. The second came on a 27-yard pass followed by a two-point conversion to cut EMU's lead to 31-15 with just 6:19 left in the game.

The Eagles left little doubt at the end, however, with Lewis scoring on his 10-yard reception with just 00:35 left. Johnson's PAT made the final score, 38-15.

Eastern, now 2-2 on the season will travel to Nashville, Tenn. Saturday, Sept. 29, to battle Vanderbilt University from the Southeastern Conference.

EAGLES DROP 30-7 NON-LEAGUE GAME AT VANDERBILT

NASHVILLE, Tenn. — The Eastern Michigan University football team fell victim to mistakes and miscues in a 30-3 loss to Vanderbilt University here at Vanderbilt Stadium Saturday, before 37,220 fans.

The Eagles could not overcome five interceptions, a lost fumble, and several other mistakes in the non-conference tilt.

Eastern will now take its 2-3 overall record into a battle of Washtenaw County next weekend, Oct. 6, when the Eagles travel seven miles west to play the University of Michigan in a noon contest. The Wolverines have rebounded from an 0-2 start and have won their last three games for a 3-2 record.

In the loss at Vanderbilt, the Eagles' defense came up with an outstanding overall effort, limiting the host Commodores to just 13 first-half points but the five interceptions proved costly.

The Eagles started the game with an interception by junior defensive lineman **Josh Hunt (Jackson, Mich.-Lumen Christi)** on Vanderbilt's first possession on the EMU 33-yard line followed by a 15-yard penalty on the home team gave the Eagles the ball on their own 47.

That sudden change lasted just three plays as Vandy came right back with an interception of its own and followed that up with a 22-yard field goal for a 3-0 lead at the 5:43 mark of the first quarter. Vandy added a touchdown at the 3:03 mark for a 10-point lead.

The EMU defense was stingy from that point, however, and held the home team scoreless until Vanderbilt's 51-yard field goal attempt was wide left with just five seconds left in the half. The Eagles were called for offsides on the play and the home team made the most of that miss by making a 45-yard field goal as time expired in the first half.

Vanderbilt made it 20-0 with an early third-quarter touchdown but the Eagles finally got on the board with 5:49 left in the third quarter when **Travis Lewis (Kalamazoo, Mich.-Loy Norrix)** caught a 14-yard pass from quarterback **Andy Schmitt (St. John's, Mich.-St. John's)** and **Zach Johnson (Springboro, Ohio-Springboro)** adding the PAT boot to cut the lead to 20-7.

The Commodores then scored the game's final 10 points to post the 30-7 win and upping their record to 3-1 on the young season.

Offensively, the Eagles were held to just 62 yards rushing and 11 yards passing with Schmitt completing 13-of-24 passes for 111 yards and three interceptions while true freshman signal caller **Kyle McMahon (Rochester Hills, Mich.-Pontiac Notre Dame Prep)** was 0-of-2 passing for no yards and two picks.

Redshirt freshman safety **Ryan Downard (Lima, Ohio-Shawnee)** turned in two interceptions for the Eagles to give him three on the year. Junior middle linebacker **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Ok-Enid)** led the way with 13 tackles while senior defensive tackle **Jason Jones (Southfield, Mich.-Lathrup)** had 11 tackles and three tackles-for-loss of nine yards.

EAGLES FALL TO WASTENAW COUNTY RIVALS, 33-22

ANN ARBOR, Mich. — The Eastern Michigan University football team fought for 60 minutes, but in the end the University of Michigan Wolverines had too many weapons as they handed the Eagles a 33-22 setback here in a non-conference matchup Saturday in Michigan Stadium.

EMU's Rynearson Stadium and Michigan Stadium are located just seven miles apart, and the game was played on Michigan's home field in front of 108,415 fans, but the large hostile crowd did not faze the Eagles as they kept pace with the Wolverines throughout.

The game had plenty of big plays from both teams, including a defensive score for the Eagles, a huge rushing day for Michigan tailback Mike Hart, two interceptions on each side, and two perfectly executed on-side kicks by EMU. In the end it came down to two lost fumbles by the Eagles that spelled doom late in the game.

After Michigan jumped out to a 10-0 lead in the first quarter, the Eagles closed out the first period with a 25-yard field goal by **Zach Johnson (Springboro, Ohio-Springboro)**.

The Wolverines made it 16-3 on a touchdown run by U-M's Mike Hart, who finished the day with 215 yards rushing on 22 attempts with three scoring runs.

On the PAT kick attempt after Hart's first touchdown, EMU's **Jason Jones (Southfield, Mich.-Lathrup)** blocked the kick and teammate **Ryan Downard (Lima, Ohio-Shawnee)** scooped up the loose ball and raced 97 yards for the two-point Eagles' defensive score, the third defensive score in school history.

Johnson tacked on a career-long 41-yard field goal with just 01:35 left in the second quarter, and Eastern entered halftime trailing, 16-8.

The Eagles started the second half with an on-side kick and Johnson recovered his own kick to give the Eagles possession.

Redshirt sophomore quarterback **Andy Schmitt (St. Johns, Mich.-St. Johns)** then capped a 57-yard drive to pull the Eagles within two, 16-14, at the 10:31 mark of the third quarter on a 10-yard touchdown run, but Johnson's PAT kick was blocked.

The Wolverines then came back with 10 straight points to go up 26-14 before disaster struck the Eagles over a brief two-minute span.

Michigan recovered a fumbled kickoff on the EMU 17-yard line and Hart made the visitors pay with a quick 17-yard touchdown run on the first play with the PAT staking the Wolverines to a 33-14 advantage.

Michigan then recovered another EMU fumble just three plays later but the Eagles dodged that bullet with sophomore defensive back **Derrick Hunter (Southfield, Mich.-Southfield)** recording the first interception of his career at the UM 5-yard line with 00:53 left in the third quarter.

The EMU defense held the Wolverines without a score over the final 15 minutes and the Eagles' offense scored eight points on an 18-yard pass from true freshman **Kyle McMahon (Rochester Hills, Mich.-Pontiac Notre Dame)** to redshirt freshman **Tyrone Burke (Syracuse, NY-Corcoran)** and a two-point conversion run by McMahon for the final eight points.

Senior **Darran Matthews (Redford, Mich.-Thurston)** and Jones led the Eagles defense with Matthews recording 11 tackles and Jones turned in 3.5 tackles-for-loss of 13 yards, including a sack for eight yards.

EAGLES DROP 48-42 SHOOTOUT IN ATHENS

ATHENS, Ohio — What was expected to be a defensive struggle turned into an old-fashioned shootout here Saturday afternoon in Peden Stadium.

Eastern Michigan and Ohio University entered the Mid-American Conference cross-divisional game with scoring averages of 17.8 for the Eagles and 23.7 for the Bobcats.

The two teams easily surpassed their averages as Ohio recorded its third victory against four setbacks with a 48-42 victory. The loss drops the Eagles to 2-5 overall and 1-2 in the MAC.

After spotting the Bobcats to a 28-0 lead after the first 18 minutes of the game, the Eagles stormed back to out-score the home team, 42-20, the rest of the game.

Eastern cut Ohio's once huge lead to just six points, 48-42, with 01:07 left when quarterback **Kyle McMahon (Rochester Hills, Mich.-Pontiac Notre Dame Prep)**, playing in relief of injured starter **Andy Schmitt (St. Johns, Mich.-St. Johns)**, hit wide receiver **Tyler Jones (Belleville, Mich.-Belleville)** for a five-yard touchdown pass with **Zach Johnson (Springboro, Ohio-Springboro)** adding his sixth PAT boot of the game.

Eastern's chance at the huge comeback win fell short, however, as an on-side kick on the ensuing kickoff was recovered by the Bobcats and allowed Ohio to run out the clock.

After Ohio jumped to the 28-0 lead, the Eagles got on the scoreboard for the first time when redshirt sophomore receiver **Jacory Stone (Southfield, Mich.-Southfield)** caught a 17-yard touchdown throw from Schmitt at the 09:02 mark of the second quarter.

Sophomore cornerback **Derrick Hunter (Southfield, Mich.-Southfield)** then picked up an Ohio U. fumble and raced 80 yards for a touchdown with Johnson adding the PAT with 05:39 left in the first half. That return by Hunter was the first fumble return for a touchdown since **Jerry Gaines** pulled off the feat on an 82-yard fumble return against Buffalo (Sept. 2, 2004).

Ohio added a field goal with 02:26 left in the first half for a 31-14 lead.

The Eagles came out for the second half with a vengeance, recording a 38-yard touchdown pass from Schmitt to **DeAnthony White (Kennesaw, Ga.-Kell)** and an eight-yard touchdown pass from Schmitt to Stone.

The EMU offense continued to roll, with Jones catching a seven-yard pass from Schmitt with 09:38 left in the game followed by the Jones TD reception with one-minute left.

Schmitt turned in a solid offensive effort before leaving with a slight shoulder injury late in the game. Schmitt completed 20-of-28 passes for 210 yards and tying his personal best with four touchdown passes. He also rushed 15 times for 55 yards.

Defensively the Eagles were led once again linebackers **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Ok.-Enid)** and **Darran Matthews (Redford, Mich.-Thurston)** with 13 and 11 tackles respectively. Defensive tackle **Jason Jones (Southfield, Mich.-Lathrup)** added eight tackles, 1.5 tackles-for-loss of 11 yards and one sack for nine yards.
